## NOUN, ADJECTIVE, BOOM!

Did you know when you throw dyed rice in the air it looks like a firework? Follow the directions below to help your child distinguish nouns (person, place or thing) vs adjectives (describing words).

1. Dye 2 bowls of uncooked, white rice with food coloring.





- 2. Once the rice is dry, go outside and read from the word lists.
- 3. For every **noun** your child hears, have them toss rice in the air from the first bowl to make a "firework". For every **adjective** they hear, repeat with the other bowl.
- 4. Repeat until you complete the word list!
